## Candy Corn Kaleidoscope Quilt

PROJECT SHEET

## Quilt is $48^{\prime \prime} \times 54$ "

What you need:

- Creative Grids Double Strip Kaleidoscope Ruler (CGRDBSKL) OR Creative Grids $45^{\circ}$ Kaleidoscope \& Dresden Plate Ruler (CGRTKAL45) or similar $45^{\circ}$ angled ruler or template plastic to make a template to cut your triangle segments)
- $21 / 2$ yards background (cream)
- 2 yards for blocks and binding (orange)
- 3 yards of backing fabric

Use the mini photo tutorial on our blog to construct your blocks If you have the Creative grids ruler instructions are included with your ruler.
For more detailed directions piecing your blocks, or if you don't have the kaleidoscope ruler or instructions, watch the YouTube video ( Link is on our blog post from 10-13-2019
OR find it on You Tube: Search on YouTube for: CGRDBSKL Creative Grids 45 Degree Kaleidoscope Double Strip Quilting Ruler, very good instructions there to make a kaleidoscope block. WE did a video also on youtube for a kaleidoscope block (different fabrics) you should still be able to find it here:

Make 42 kaleidoscope blocks, alternating the placement of your corner triangles to make 2 different kaleidoscope blocks. 21 or 22 of each block, depending on how you start laying out your rows


Assemble blocks into seven rows of 6 blocks each.
Layer quilt and bind.
Add more fabric to make more blocks if you want to make a larger quilt

If you don't have a $45^{\circ}$ triangle ruler in your sewing stuff, you can make a template to cut your segments out with. if you're going to use a template- it is harder to stay accurate. So, I suggest making a test block out of scrap fabric- to make sure it comes out at the right size.
