Twisted Vintage Valentine

Use the Lil' Twister Ruler to Make this quilt. Other sizes of twisters will make the finished quilt size bigger or smaller accordingly. When using the Lil' Twister- Cut 5" Squares:

- 10 Dark Red Squares (1/3 yard)
- 11 Deep Pink Squares (1/3 yard)
- 6 Medium Pink Squares (1/6) yard
- 7 Light Pink Squares (1/6) yard
- 15 Background squares (1/3 yard)
- 4 strips 3 ½" x WOF Background (1/2 yard)

Use color block diagram to layout squares. Stitch rows together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Then sew the 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips to all 4 sides. Now give it the 'Twister Treatment". See the general instructions for using the Lil' Twister ruler in the package your ruler came in.

After you stitch your cut twister shapes back into rows and sew the rows together, the unfinished size of your piece should measure about 24 ½" square (see figure 1). You can quilt and bind your piece just like this or you can add more borders to it. See page 2 for border instructions.

Adding Borders:

- First Border: Cut 4 strips of cream background fabric 2 ½" x WOF (1/3 yard in addition to amount listed on page 1)
- Second Border: Cut 4 strips of dark red outer border fabric 3 ½" x WOF (1/2 yard in addition to amount listed on pg. 1)
- Corner Stones: Cut 4 squares of deep pink 3 ½" x 3
 ½" (can be cut from leftover of deep pink from amount listed on page 1)
- Binding cut 2 strips 2 ¼" x WOF (¼ yard)

Refer to figure 2 to add borders in order shown. Quilt and Bind
