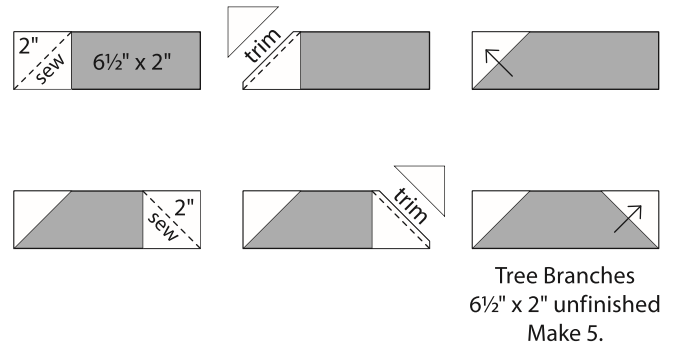
1 Tree

(A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of $2-3\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares. Layer a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " marked background square, right sides together, on $1-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " tree rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 1.

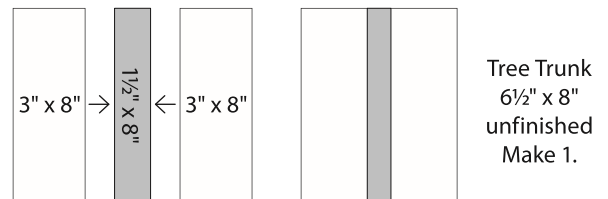

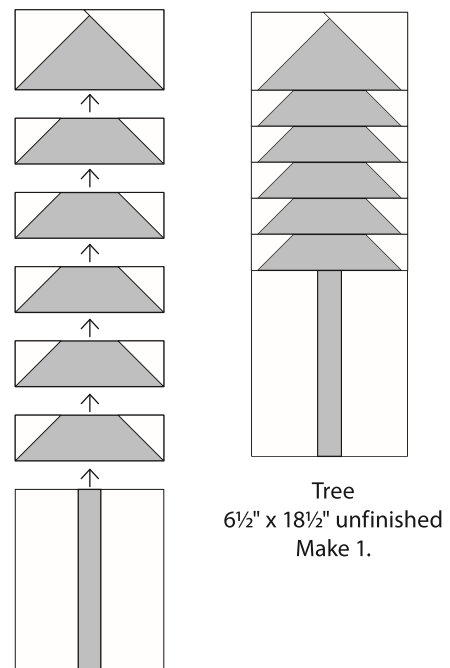
(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of $10-2$ " background squares. Layer 2 " marked background square, right sides together, on $1-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 " tree rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 5.



(C) Join $2-3$ " x 8 " background and $1-1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 " tree trunk as shown. Make 1.

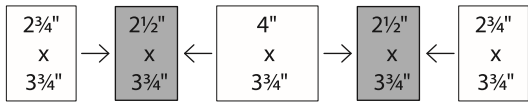

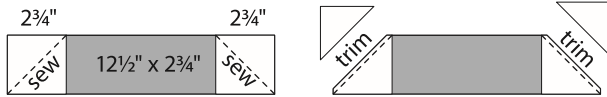
2 Chimney, Roof, and Windows

(A) Join $2-2\frac{3}{4}" \times 3\frac{3}{4}"$ backgrounds, $2-2\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{3}{4}"$ chimneys, and $1-4" \times 3\frac{3}{4}"$ background as shown to make the chimneys.



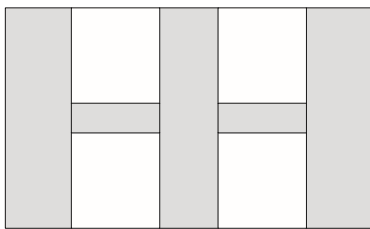
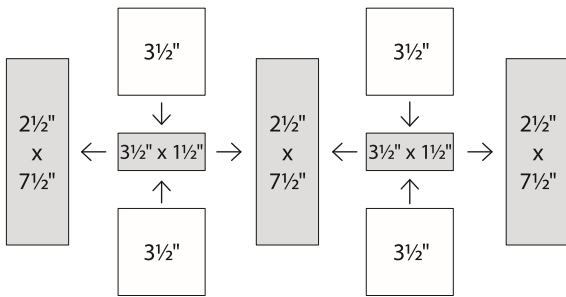

Trim $\frac{1}{4}"$ from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle.



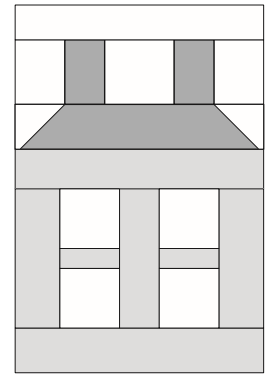
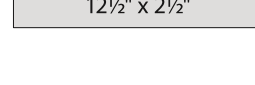
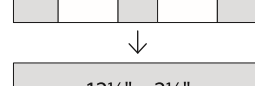
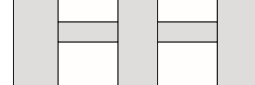
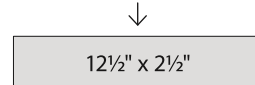
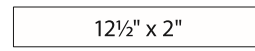

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–5" background squares. Layer a 5" marked background square, right sides to together, on 1–9 1/2" x 5" roof rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 1.

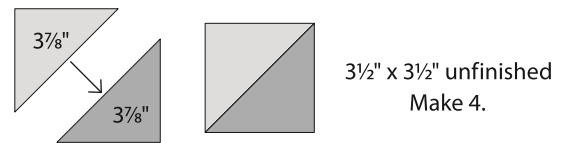

Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle using the marked chimney square. Make 1.

Trim the 6" house square only, $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle. Make 2. Join to make the house roof.

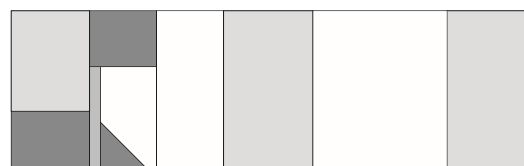
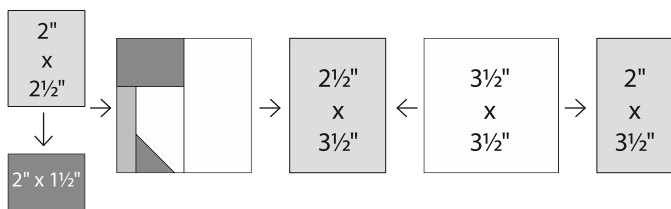
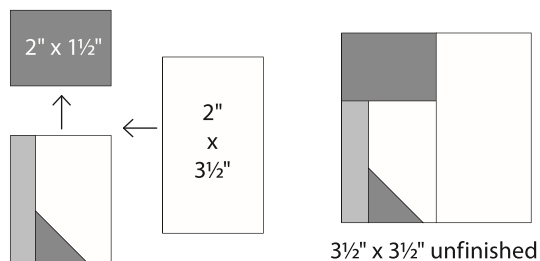
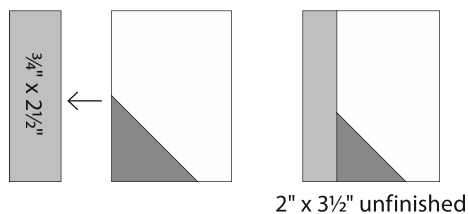
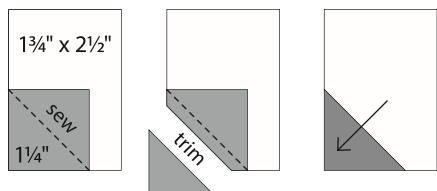
- Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 1–1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " background and 1–1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " mailbox roof squares. Layer a marked background square, right sides to together, on the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " mailbox front as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat using the marked 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " mailbox square on the opposite corner as shown. Appliqué the circle to the front. Add a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " background rectangle as shown.

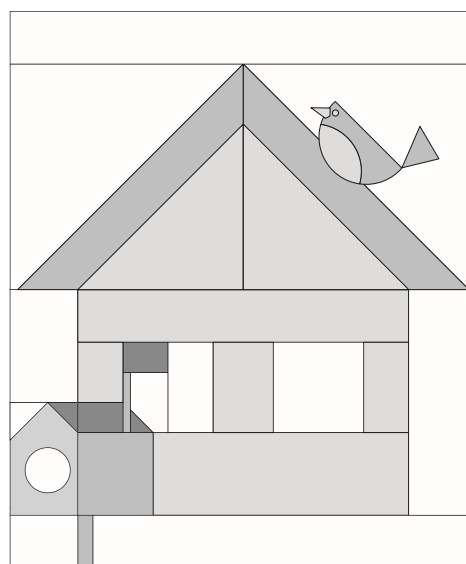
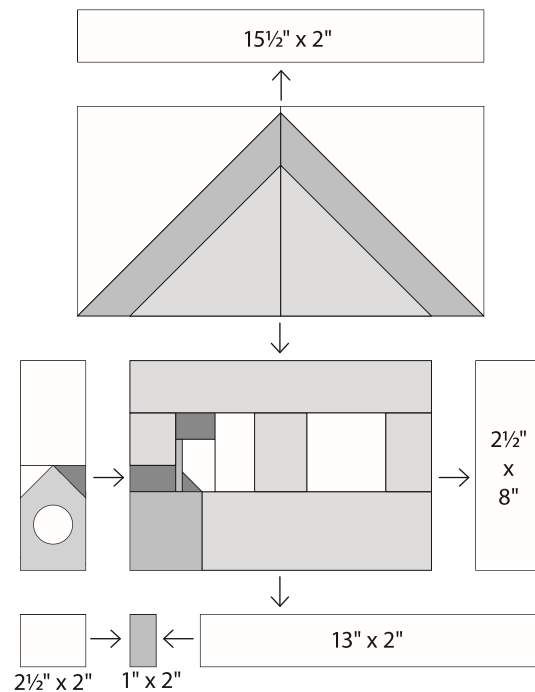
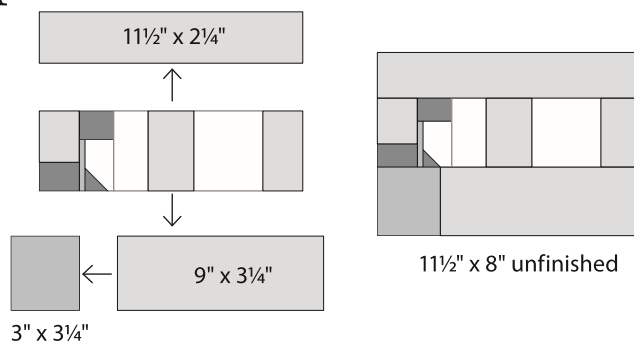
Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 1-1/4" mailbox roof square. Layer the marked square, right sides to together, on the 1 3/4" x 2 1/2" window as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle.

1 House Rooftops A, B, C, and D

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of $4-3\frac{1}{2}$ " house squares and $6-3\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares.

The same technique is used to make all the roof tops. Just note whether you are using a marked house or marked background square. Layer a marked square, right sides to together, on $1-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " roof rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle.

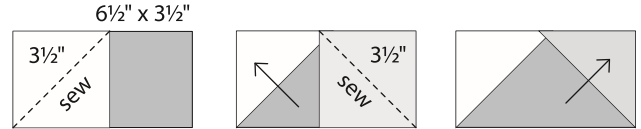

Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 2 leaf As and 2 leaf Bs. *Note the 2" square placement is different.*



(B) Arrange and sew 2-Leaf As and 1-2" background square to make column A. Arrange sew 1-2" background square and sew 2-Leaf Bs to make column B. Join the columns, add a 3 1/2" x 5" background rectangle. Add 2-1 1/2" x 12 1/2" background rectangles. Use you appliqué method of choice to add the circles.

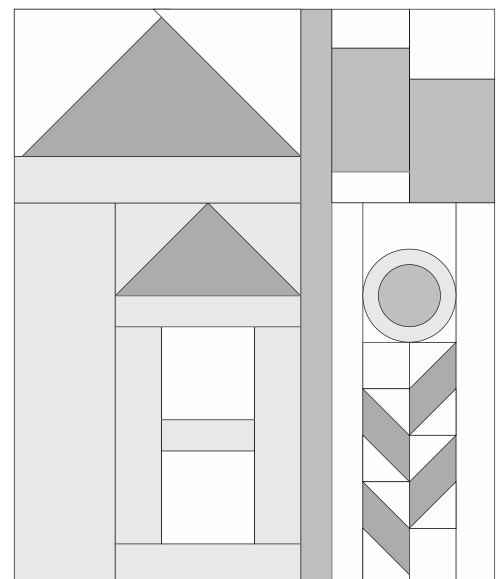
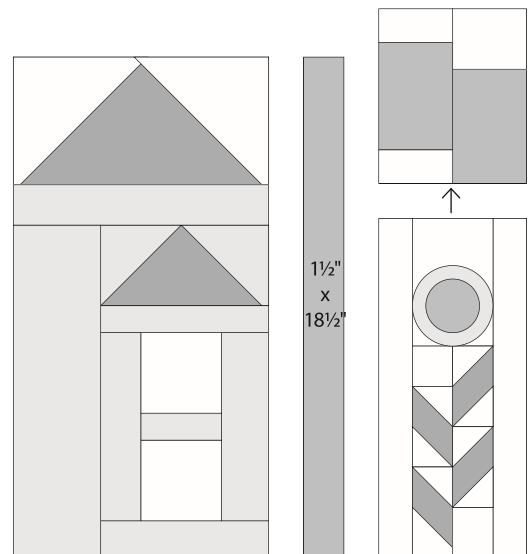
