




Assembly


- 1. The block is assembled in quadrants using log cabin piecing techniques to assemble the quadrants. Begin by laying out (1) of each A-I unit as shown.
- 2. Begin assembling the block by sewing layers onto the quadrant center beginning with the A square. Continue attaching layers in a clockwise formation. For all layers, press outward and away from the A square.
- 3. Repeat to make (4) quadrants measuring 6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished.



- 4. Continue block assembly by laying out all (4) quadrants as shown. Each quadrant is turned a different direction.
- 5. Sew quadrants together. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Completed block should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½" unfinished.
