



Cut Square Once Diagonally

	0
Α	(2) 4 5/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (4) A triangles. <i>Grunge 30150-254</i>
В	(2) 4 5/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (4) B triangles. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
с	(16) 1 ³ / ₄ " squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side. <i>Grunge 30150-254</i>
D	(8) 1 ³ / ₄ " x 4 ¹ / ₄ " rectangles. <i>Grunge 30150-82</i>
E	(4) 1 ¾" x 3" rectangles. <i>Grunge 30150-254</i>
F	(12) 1 ³ / ₄ " squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (8) squares. Set the remaining squares aside. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
G	(1) 4 ¼" square. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
н	(1) 1 ¼" x 11 ¾" rectangle. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
Ι	(1) 1 ¼" x 12 ½" rectangle. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>

Assembly


- Begin block assembly by making HST units. Place (1) A triangle with (1) B triangle, right sides together and edges aligned.
- 3. Trim the HST unit to measure $4 \frac{1}{4}$ x $4 \frac{1}{4}$ unfinished. Press to the A triangle.
- 4. Repeat to make (4) identical HST units.
- 5. Place (1) C square with a drawn diagonal line onto the "B" side of an HST unit, right sides together and edges aligned.
- 6. Sew along the drawn diagonal line.
- Trim outermost excess fabric to ¼" and press to the corner. Repeat stitch and flip techniques using the remaining HST units and (3) C squares.








8. Using stitch and flip techniques described above, place (1) C square with a drawn diagonal line onto each corner of (1) G square. Stitch, flip and press. Set aside as the block center.







- 9. Using stitch and flip techniques described above, place (1) C square with a drawn diagonal line and (1) F square with a drawn diagonal line onto opposite ends of (1) D rectangle. Please note the orientation of the C and F squares.
- 10. Stitch, flip and press. Repeat to make (4) identical stitch and flip units using C, D and F units. Repeat to make (4) **mirror image** stitch and flip units using C, D and F units. Refer to diagrams for accurate fabric placement. Units should measure 1 ³/₄" x 4 ¹/₄" unfinished.





- 11. Sew (1) E rectangle to (1) F square as shown. Press toward the F rectangle.
- 12. Repeat to make (4) identical E/F units measuring 1 ¼" x 4 ¼" unfinished.



- 13. Lay out all units created in the above steps as shown. Please note the placement of mirror image stitch and flip units as well as the rotation of the HST units.
- 14. Sew together in rows. Arrows indicate pressing instructions, or press open to reduce bulk.
- 15. Sew rows together. Block should measure 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ " at this step.











- 16. Sew (1) H rectangle to the left side of the block as shown. Press outward toward the H rectangle.
- 17. Sew (1) I rectangle to the bottom of the block as shown. Press outward toward the I rectangle to complete the block. Block should measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.











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
