


A Garden for Harper

Pattern by *moda* Quilt is 72" x 72"



FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Prints:	1 Jelly Roll*
Background:	1 solid Jelly Roll plus ½ yard same fabric
Binding:	³ / ₄ yard
Backing:	4½ yards
	*Jelly Roll = $40 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips

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A Garden for Harper Quilt is 72" x 72"

CUTTING

BACKGROUND (use 3 strips from background Jelly Roll and 6 strips from 1/2 yard)

Subcut 9-2¹/₂" x WOF strips into 72-2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangles.

BINDING


8-21/2" x width of fabric strips

Sew the 8 strips end to end to make the binding.

CONSTRUCTION Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams and press in the direction of the arrows.


Make 2

- 1. To make one block:
- (A) Join 1 print and 1 background 2½" x WOF strip. Cut the strip set into 8-2½" and 4-4½" wide segments. Join 2-2½" wide segments. Make 3. Join 1-2½" segment and 1-4½" x 2½" background rectangle. Make 2.




(B) Arrange and sew the units in rows as shown. Join the rows to make 1 block. Repeat to make 36 blocks.

Make 3




 Arrange and sew 6 rows in 6 blocks each as shown. Alternate direction of the blocks so that each 2x2 block section creates a 'circle' in the center of background fabric.

at ROLL



3. Press the seams in opposite direction from row to row. Join the rows. Layer, quilt and bind.



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
